Nirav Dalal: The Lions need to take their No. 6 ranking on a road show this weekend with a stop in West Lafayette, IN. The Lions will face the Boilers in Joe Tiller's final year pacing the sidelines. The Boilers are coming off of a terrible loss to Notre Dame and have been underperforming in big games but they definitely have the talent to compete with the Lions. The Boilers have called for a "Black Out" but we'll see if it is the Lions that call it "Lights Out" for the Boilers if the men in black can make this game a nightmare for JoePa's squad.

Mark Harrington: Wow, what a game last Saturday. We'll Paterno said after the win to enjoy it, because Monday it's back to business – and that is how the team has approached this. Will the Big Ten road woes continue from recent years for PSU or will they manage to create that spark they have shown at home? This game could be an emotional one for the Boilers or they could "boil over" as they did against Notre Dame.

Other Big Games This Weekend:

ND: It seems like every week there is another team that the media is crowning as a "BCS Buster." ECU was an early favorite but has quickly been replaced by BYU. The other team that has been thrown into the mix is Utah and they will face the Oregon State, who is coming off of an upset win over USC. The Beavers are going to come back down to earth and will drop an ugly one against the Utes in this one, which will set the Utes up nicely for that big showdown in Salt Lake City against BYU in the season closer.

MH: Wow, who would have thought Auburn vs. Vanderbilt would have been a big game, but the No. 13 Tigers square off with the No. 19 Commodores in what could be an interesting showdown. And let's not forget that Big Ten showdown as No. 14 Ohio State heads on the road to face No. 18 Wisconsin, in what should be a telling game in the race for the Big Ten crown.

Upset Special:

ND: Mark, you can include me in the list of people that just refuse to jump on the Tyrelle Pryor band wagon. He is destined to come back down to earth when defenses realize that he is staring down his receivers and doesn't really have much pocket presence. The perfect place for this "grounding" is a night game in Camp Randall against an angry Badger team who lost in a heartbreaker to the Wolverines. Look for the Badgers to play great in front of the home crowd and send the Buckeyes back to Columbus with a conference loss.

MH: Call me crazy, but I am expecting Oregon's high-octane offense to give USC a run. Could the state of Oregon play spoiler again for Troy? Oregon is averaging 48 points per game, so this one could be an interesting one.

Offense:

ND: The Lions continue to exhibit the type of balance that has been characteristic of every successful team that JoePa has had over the decades. Daryll Clark has been the shot in the arm that this offense desperately needed. People talk about his ability to run and his accuracy but I think his ability to focus on the moment and shake off previous bad plays has been refreshing. This kid, so far, can't be rattled. But, with the quality of the offensive line that he has in front of him, there is no reason to be rattled. Cadogan has been playing lights out this year. This has helped Evan Royster scamper to becoming one of the best TBs in the conference. The Boilers, on the other hand, have been terrible against the run. The telling tale has been that the Boilers have given up most of those yards while playing a nickel defense

because the teams that they faced are lining up 3 and 4 WRs. Look for the Lions to take advantage of this by going away from the I formation and running more decide options and single back sets. 5th year senior, Anthony Heygood is the leading tackler for the Boilers and does a good job of filling gaps on runs. He has tallied 40 tackles this year so it'll be critical for the offensive line to get a hat on him to keep the running lanes open for whomever might be running the ball.

One of the real mysteries to me is how the Boilers are so bad against the pass. They face the pass all the time in practice against one of the best passing teams in the Big Ten and they have a very experienced secondary with mostly seniors. But, they are still giving up almost 245 yards per game through the air. Though Norwood didn't play last week and Butler was covered by Vontae Davis, the Lions were still able to make plenty of plays through the air with Derrick Williams, Graham Zug, and Andrew

Quarless. I expect the Lions to continue to line up 3 receivers, run the ball, and then start to utilize the play action pass to open up those medium yardage routes. Clark will need to continue to take care of the football and make the right throws. He has had his primary option open most times and it's been a safe throw. He needs to continue to find those right options and deliver the football in the right space.

The Lions offense has too many playmakers and the Boilers are bad against the run and the pass. It'll be a pick your poison for Brock Spock, the Purdue defensive coordinator. I will expect him to play a base defense to prevent big plays and force the Lions to execute to move the ball. But, this is where the Lions offense has been most successful this year.

MH: Although the Lions have been pretty balanced so far, I expect that the scales may tip in favor of the running game in this one. As you said, Purdue has simply been unable to plug up the running game of opposing offenses and with a heady running back like Royster and a physical line like PSU's this could spell trouble for the Wet Lafayette Gang. In fact the coaches gave Royster an extra day of rest, sitting him out of practice on Monday to help him prepare for this game. Saddle up to the workhorse.

In terms of the passing game there have been a few developments this week. Jordan Norwood, who missed the Illinois game with a hamstring injury has not practiced through Tuesday and is questionable for the Purdue game. I suspect according to our conversations with practice observers that they may let him rest again this week in preparation for the Big Ten gauntlet on the horizon. Also, the coaches see to expect that Purdue may key on Derrick Williams – what ever could have given them that idea? Well, his 260 odd all-purpose yards vs. Illinois should have the Boilers' attention.

This means opportunity is knocking for Butler, Powell, Quarless, Brackett and Zug. Luckily for PSU eight different players have caught touchdown passes through the first five games this season, so he has a lot of targets to go to out there. In terms of the scheme PSU isn't expected to change much up this week – watch for them to leverage the combination of speed, motion and misdirection to keep the Boilers on their heels.

Defense:

ND: The Boilers offense starts with Curtis Painter, the senior quarterback. Many felt that with the amount of experience he had coming into this season and with the receivers on the squad that Painter would be one of the best QBs in the season. But, with losses to Oregon and Notre Dame have quickly changed that. At this point, the Boilers are glad to be starting their Big Ten portion of the schedule with the hopes to turn things around and contend for a top spot in the Big Ten pecking order.

Painter has been completing 57.4% of his passes this year but has already thrown 4 INTs. He has been very erratic and has not helped his team win games down the stretch. Instead, it has been the play of Kory Sheets that has helped this team stay in games and win games. Sheets is averaging almost 6 yards per carry and 104 yards per game. He's a small, fast, but physical

back. The real question mark will be if he can play this weekend against the Lions. Sheets suffered a separated shoulder against the Irish and though early reports are that he will be available, I find it hard to believe that he can play at the same level of competence. Regardless of Sheets' status, Dan Dierking is listed as #2 on the depth chart. But, I think Tiller will go with Justin Siller. Siller came to Purdue has a dual-threat QB and moved to RB this fall to help with some lacking depth at that position. Look for Siller to get most of the carries in this game if Sheet can't go. The Lions continued to show some inability to stop the run between the tackles. When players have tried to run wide, Bowman, Rubin, and Maybin have been there to shut it down. But, over the center, the Lions opponents have had some success. We'll see if Josh Hull or one of the younger MLBs, Sukay, Mauti, or Colasanti, can be more aggressive and make their reads quicker this week. Eventually, this inability will catch up to the Lions but I don't think it will be this week.

Painter does have a myriad of WRs to throw to. Greg Orton is the guy that gets all of the attention. But, the Lions need to be concerned with Desmond Tardy. Tardy is averaging over 15 yards per catch and he has some blazing speed. The Lions need to continue to lock down on receivers but, more importantly, they have to play their assignments properly when dropping into a zone-coverage. The Lions have given up a number of TDs this season on completely blown coverage in the secondary.

Painter will throw the ball all over the field but because the Boilers won't have a running threat, Maybin, Evans, and Odrick will be able to put pressure on Painter. Ultimately, this will trigger a bunch of turnovers.

MH: The defense has made a shift this week with their approach from containment (of Juice Williams) to collapsing (of Curtis Painter's pocket). The defensive ends were held back a bit against Illinois based on the coaches' concern that if the made a corner high on a speed rush Williams would simply step low and hit the open inside lane for a big pickup. Painter is not quite as mobile or quick as Williams, so the defensive front four are looking to "dial up" that pressure and force him to make quick decisions or flush him to Bowman and Gbadyu.

Speaking on Bowman he had another big game against Illinois and on the year leads the team with 45 tackles (25 solo). In fact, the coaches see him as so valuable the rested him on Monday and Tuesday in order to "get him to 100%" according to one practice observer. The combination of Maybin, Bowman, Gbadyu and Gaines on the edges should really force Painter to the air, where he is comfortable.

In terms of the secondary, Scirrotto was cramping up during last week's game, but is fine now. Also, Astorino should play a significant role in this game as he did last week, making some key plays. Also, watch for a heavier dose of A.J. Wallace at corner, as he has seeming taken over the starting role since filling in for Sargeant during the Illini clash.

These guys have to account, as you pointed out, for Orton, but Tardy is the threat few know about. He can really create

space and grab those yards after the catch. PSU has to nail down their zone releases, which were dropped last week when Benn had that big sideline TD catch and run. Otherwise, Painter will be able to hit the routes and find some comfort.

Special Teams:

ND: What the heck is going on with kick-offs? One week, the Lions couldn't stop an octogenarian from returning a kick to midfield. Now, the Lions can't seem to get the ball in the air or keep it in bounds. Whether it is Wagner or Kelly, they need to drive the football and keep it in the field of play.

The Lions also need to add another threat on kicks or Derrick Williams may have seen his last ball kicked to him this year. AJ Wallace needs to pick his lane and explode through it. Dancing in the hole may look nice on TV but it won't gain yards.

Fortunately for the Lions, the Boilers are pretty bad in stopping punt returns. Chris Summers is punting well but the coverage has left something to be desired yielding almost 12 yards per return. This provides both Williams and Scirrotto with some excellent opportunities to flip the field position.

MH: Wow, Derrick Williams got the fourth return TD of his career last week (two on PRs, two on KR). If the Boilers are not careful he could bust another one open on this one. As for kicking Wagner booted that kickoff out of bounds, so I suspect that has all but nailed down the kickoff job for Kelly.

The coverage was improved last week though, so at least they are containing better and staying in those lanes to stop any big returns.

Matchup to Kick Back and Enjoy:

ND: The Lions will face one of the better receiving tandems in the conference this week. I like the matchup of the Lions' secondary against Greg Orton and Desmond Tardy. Both receivers have been very pro-

ductive and have been making big plays. The Lions struggled against Rejus Benn and we'll see how they fare against two quality receivers.

MH: That should be a dandy. I am going with PSU's defensive edges with Maybin, Gaines, Bowman, Gbadyu and company against Painter. Can they collapse and contain Painter and force him to make quick decisions that result in some key mistakes PSU can capitalize on?

Keys to the Game:

ND: Both teams really like to have a balanced attack. The reason that the Boilers have struggled this year is that they have not been able to run the ball effectively this year. Likewise, the reason the Lions have been so successful is because they have been very balanced. If one defense can force their opponent to be one-dimensional, then that will be a huge advantage in this game.

MH: I am going with intensity for Penn State. If they come out fired up instead of flat it'll make all the difference in this game. They need to shake off these road issues and come out with the gusto they show at home.

Predictions:

ND: The Lions have the perfect road trip to get ready for big tests against Wisconsin and Ohio State. The Boilers are far too soft on defense and their running attack is severely hampered with a banged up Kory Sheets. That spells disaster for Joe Tiller.

MH: This is a good road game to help PSU ease into the Big Ten gauntlet on the horizon. With issues around their rushing defense, watch for PSU to lean towards the ground game early to open up the air attack.
