



## Ohio State Edition October 25, 2008

**Nirav Dalal:** Well, the Lions played a great second half of football and that was enough to bury the Wolverines. Meanwhile, the Buckeyes capitalized on an afternoon of Spartan turnovers to pummel Michigan State. The two top teams in the Big Ten square off in Columbus for an inside track to the Rose Bowl or maybe something more. The Buckeye faithful have called for Scarlet Fever with their fans all dressing in red. We'll see if the Lions can make them feel blue.

**Mark Harrington:** Despite the slow start, the difference with this team compared to recent PSU teams for me is that I had confidence that they would buckle down and come back from the adversity. They did thanks to their talent, but more importantly, their leadership. Coach Jim Tressell and the Buckeye Scout site are begging fans to come loud to impact the game. It should be interesting.

### Other Big Games This Weekend:

**ND:** It seems like Texas has the most treacherous October schedule in the country. After beating Oklahoma and dismantling Missouri, their reward is the 7-0 Oklahoma State Cowboys. Gundy's kids are scoring an average of 46.4 points per game while the Horns are averaging 48.1 points per game. I like Colt McCoy to continue his mix of running the ball and throwing the ball. Plus, Texas' defense played very well against Missouri when the game mattered and I think they'll corral the Cowboys.

**MH:** That is a biggie. How about No. 7 Georgia heading to No. 13 LSU? The SEC has seen a heated race, and both the Bulldogs and Tigers are digging in to finish out strong. Also, the Big 12 could shake out further as No. 8 Texas Tech takes their high-flying offense to No. 23 Kansas, coming off a tough loss to Oklahoma.

### Upset Special:

**ND:** I am not a believer of the USC team that is walking through the PAC-10 schedule since it lost to the Oregon State Beavers. They had a very uninspired win against Arizona State, and I'm pretty sure that my local pee-wee team could have hung 50 on the Washington State Cougars. This week, the Trojans will face Arizona's Willie Tuitama, who has an excellent arm. I like Arizona in this game because it's at home and that offense can score some serious points.

**MH:** Watch for Virginia Tech to seek out some revenge for that BC loss as they head south to face No. 25 Florida State. The Noles have been eeking out wins this season and if Frank Beamer can nail down the special teams and get back to basics, the Hokies could get back on track in the ACC race.

### Offense:

**ND:** Penn State's offense got off the blocks with a stumble against Michigan but did a really good job executing in the 2-minute drill before the half and in the second quarter. The Lions were able to move the ball very well against a Michigan defense that was one of the better run defenses in the country.

But, their most impressive performance was against the constant blitzes that the Wolverines threw at them. Daryll Clark was able to deliver the football and avoid taking sacks. He was comfortable getting the ball out early and Jay Paterno did a good job of calling short pass plays to eliminate the impact of the pass rush. Clark's accuracy under pressure has been critical in Big Ten play and it will be just as big this week.

Ohio State will play a very similar defense to what they did against Michigan State – load up the box and blitz someone on every down. I think we'll see more flanker screens and swing

passes to get the ball out of Clark's hand and to the receivers in space. Malcolm Jenkins has been a thorn in the Lions' side over the last meetings. Jenkins has returned an interception for a TD in the last 2 games and he's going to be on the field again this weekend. Clark needs to continue to be smart with the football and not get rushed into making a bad throw because he is under duress. He has not had to throw the football away very often this season but it needs to be an option rather than taking risks.

The offensive line and Evan Royster have been a major reason that the Lions have been able to dominate games. Royster is averaging 7.7 yards per carry, which is fifth in the nation. He has an uncanny ability to get small in the hole and then bounce his runs to the outside to gobble up big chunks of yards. We'll see if All-American and former Butkus Award winner, James Laurinaitis is able to get into the hole and force Royster to power through or bounce it back. Waiting for him will be another stellar linebacker, Marcus Freeman. This duo has accumulated 128 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss, and six sacks on the season. The offensive line will need to hit their blocks and then get to the next level to put a hat on both of these guys. If Laurinaitis and Freeman are accounted for, Royster should have no issues running the ball down the throat of the Buckeyes.

I'm expecting the Buckeyes to stuff the box, which will make running the ball tough early on. But, if Clark is able to get the ball to Jordan Norwood, Derrick Williams, and Deon Butler on the outside and then use the play action to get Andrew Quarless involved, it should start to open up some running lanes. The keys will be protecting Clark and making smart decisions with the

**MH:** It was a slow start once again for the Lions. Clearly this is not a first quarter team by all accounts. The good news is that they have shown they have the ability to be a second, third and fourth quarter team though. I agree with you Nirav. We're likely to see Ohio State man-up on Royster in an effort to force Clark to throw, which has not exactly been a weak point for the PSU helmetsman.

Watch for Ohio State to put a lot of pressure on the pocket to get Clark on edge and clog up the lanes. Ohio State does have the second best pass defense in the conference (behind Penn State), but they also have the No. 1 rushing defense, so Clark and company have a tall order in front of them.

The Bucks will key on Royster, so it is imperative that PSU get some passes out to ratchet back the defense. However, if there is a back that can identify defensive breaks with pin-point accuracy, it's Royster. We'll see if he can do the same against a tough, tough OSU defense.

The PSU offense has to look to that balanced attack and be ready to shift gears as Ohio State adjusts. As the cliché goes, "take what the defense gives you." If OSU does put eight or nine in the box, Clark should look to his sizeable inside targets – Quarless, Mickey Shuler and Brett Brackett and his backfield weapons – Williams, Chaz Powell and Royster as targets.

I spoke to Clark on Wednesday and he seems relaxed and focused. He realizes that he needs to settle down and not focus on proving something to his home state of Ohio. If he can play his game and protect the ball PSU should be able to put up a fight.

#### Defense:

**ND:** The Lions really struggled against the Wolverines early on when they were utilizing a nickel defense with Josh Hull and a combination of Tyrell Sales/Navorro Bowman as the two linebackers. After going back to a 4-3 defense and getting Mike Mauti into the game, the defense settled down and was able to stop the running game of the Wolverines.

It'll be interesting to see what Coach Tom Bradley dials up for the Buckeyes, but I think we will see the 4-4 lineup that he used from time-to-time against the Wisconsin Badgers. This will help the Lions get speed at the linebacker position on the field, which will help slow down the Beanie Wells and Terrelle Pryor running game. Wells is a physical back that likes to run between the tackles and muscle his way to big games. Meanwhile, Pryor is a tall, fast, elusive runner that takes advantage of a spread out defense to beat guys that can't tackle well in open space.

A 4-4 defense would give the Lions the ability to plug holes up the middle and also play wide enough to contain Pryor. Regardless of what scheme is used, the Lions must attack the football and finish their tackles. There were far too many missed tackles in the first couple of series against the Wolverines, which allowed Brandon Minor to gain big yards.

In the passing game, the Buckeyes continue to be one of the worst in the Big Ten and Pryor has shown that he can heave the ball down the field to his receivers but

he is far from a savvy passer. He lacks the touch necessary for the short and intermediate routes to keep the chains moving. He also seems to struggle with feeling pressure especially from his blind side. This plays right to the advantage of Aaron Maybin, who is 16th in the nation in forced fumbles, 2nd in the nation in solo sacks, and 3rd in the nation in tackles for loss. Maybin has been charging hard from the blind side of right-handed QBs and Pryor will need to have an internal clock to get rid of that football or Maybin will be on his back pretty quick. The Lions have also been going with Maurice Evans on the opposite side of Maybin, which is giving them probably the best pass rushing bookends in the country. When Pryor is able to get rid of the football, he has been throwing to Brian Robiskie and Brian Hartline. Both are tall and talented receivers. Though Ray Small is second on the team in catches, Robiskie and Hartline are the ones that Pryor has been throwing the ball to down the field. This game will serve as the biggest challenge for the Penn State secondary. Drew Astorino has performed very well in nickel situations and he will need to play very well in this game as the Buckeyes will try to stretch the field to open up lanes for the run.

The Buckeyes should see success running the ball with Wells. He is too good of a back to shut down completely. Much like the Wisconsin game, the Lions will need to try to stop him and Pryor to get the Buckeyes into obvious passing situations, which is when the Lions gain a tremendous advantage against the Buckeye offensive line that has struggled in pass protection. If Wells is able to get 4-5 yards per carry, the Lions will be vulnerable to the deep pass off of play action.

**MH:** Penn State had some wrong alignments on the defensive line and blitz packages. Once they adjusted against Michigan they were fine. The key for this game is recognizing the issues and making the shifts faster. PSU cannot afford to fall too far behind in this game.

I expect Penn State to focus on stopping Wells and containing Pryor, making the true freshman beat them with his arm. Keep in mind Ohio State is dead last in the conference in pass offense, behind Michigan, with 140 yards per game through the air. This is what PSU has to exploit.

I get the feeling Pryor is not completely comfortable with his tosses yet and seems concerned with throwing an interception. This can play into PSU's favor. Word out of practice is Anthony Scirrotto could play back from the concussion he sustained against Michigan, however watch for Astorino to get into the action as well.

A big factor is the defensive line's ability to pressure and contain Pryor. They have shown they can do this with Juice Williams, who tends to be a better passer, but Pryor's size and strength will require consistent low wrap-ups. The rotation of Abe Koroma, Jared Odrick and Ollie Ogbu inside should be able to supply consistent pressure, but the question is can Evans and Maybin get pressure off the edges?

#### Special Teams:

**ND:** If there is one thing that Jim Tressell's crew can do, it is play special teams. He has an excellent punter in AJ Trapasso. He is averaging 42.9 punts per

game and has dropped nine punts within the 20 yard line.

Small is another guy to keep an eye on. He is an explosive punt returner, who is averaging 14 yards per punt and has taken one punt for a touchdown. The Lions will have to continue their excellent special teams play because the Buckeyes are using special teams to get advantages in games when their offense is sputtering.

**MH:** This should be a good battle of solid special team units. It could come down to a big return or kick, so Kevin Kelly, Williams and company have to be ready to excel. I suspect Paterno will play things safe on returns, but he really should unleash Williams to give him a shot to break a return open and shift the momentum over to the blue side.

In terms of Small, PSU has to stick with their solid coverage play, which was very strong against Michigan. If they can force OSU into some long drives it will give them a chance to create some opportunities.

#### Matchup to Kick Back and Enjoy:

**ND:** I am very excited to see how the speed of the Lions defense matches up with Pryor, who has yet to be forced to throw the football to win the game. We'll see how well the Lions can contain his runs and put pressure on him in the pocket. This matchup is not only going to be fun to watch, but will dictate the outcome of the game.

**MH:** Nice pick. I am going with how Clark handles the pressure of the fast and furious front seven of OSU. He'll need to be sharp and decisive on his plays and "take what the defense gives him."

#### Keys to the Game:

**ND:** The Lions have to tackle well in this game. Beanie Wells possesses one of the nastiest stiff arms in the country and if the Lions put their heads down when trying to tackle them, they will end up eating turf and watching Wells scamper by. The elusiveness of Pryor also makes the ability to wrap-up and take him down paramount. Too many teams have taken bad angles and tried to arm-tackle Pryor and we'll see if the Lions become the subject of his next highlight clip or if they can keep him contained in the pocket.

**MH:** I think this one comes down to mistakes and momentum. Penn State has to protect the ball and they cannot allow Ohio State to get an early momentum shift like Michigan had last week. Ohio State will preserve that and not just implode like the Wolverines did.

#### Predictions:

**ND:** The Lions will struggle against the run in this game and will have a real dog fight on their hands. I think Clark will make a couple of plays late and the kicking of Kevin Kelly will help this team pull out a win to keep the undefeated season alive.

#### Penn State 27 Ohio State 21

**MH:** This is a tough one. I had this circled as a loss, but the PSU team has proven they are a Lion of a different color. First winning in Camp Randall, and then booting the U-M monkey. Now, they have the tools and talent to shake off the Horseshoe issues. I think we'll see a back and forth battle with a determined Clark and company eking one out in the 'Shoe.
